

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded for such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class, except as provided in Ch.11, Sec.6, AKC Rules.

CLEANING UP: "Cleanup Stations" will be placed around the show rings. If your dog soils the grounds, it is your responsibility to clean up. ### **PAST DUE PAYMENT POLICY:**

No new trophy donations or advertising pledges will be accepted by the Labrador Retriever Club, Inc. from individuals with outstanding bills owed to the LRC. Entries will not be accepted from individuals who, after a minimum of one billing per month for three months, continue to owe for outstanding bills. The LRC Show Treasurer will furnish the Show Superintendent of the current National Specialty show with an up-to-date list of these individuals. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Show Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

### CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

**RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

**STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dogs and at least two (2), but not more than three (3), of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the Standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other non-Regular Class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**BRACE CLASS** - Two Labrador Retrievers that are similar in appearance, performing in unison. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The Dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars MUST be given for each dog on individual entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for "Best of Breed Competition" and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," Brace No. 2," etc. The entry fee for Brace Competition is \$30.00 per Brace.\*
