NOTE: If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged up to the limit set by the AKC regulations.

DRAWING FOR ENTRY ACCEPTANCE: A drawing will be held by the Secretary of the test at 7:00 p.m. on September 16, 2015 at the her residence to determine which entries will participate in the tests and the position of excess entrants on the alternate list. Entries will be acknowledged with draw number and directions to the test site. Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted Entrant is absent on the day of the test, the first Alternate present shall assume the vacant position, according to the order in which they were drawn.

DRAWING FOR TRACK POSITION: Track order will be drawn by lot at 7:45 A.M. for TDU exhibitors and 9:45 A.M. for VST exhibitors on the day of the test at the Test Site Headquarters. Entrants and Alternates must be present at the drawing to guarantee their participation in the test. The first tracks will be run immediately following the draw.

REFUND POLICIES: Entry fee will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judges, or barred from competition by the test committee. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

After closing, an Entrant may declare they are going to be absent on test day. If an Alternate is available on test day, the Entrant will receive a refund. If an Alternate is not available on test day, the Entrant will not receive a refund. A refund to an Entrant will not be made until after the test is complete. Alternates may withdraw from the test after closing and receive a refund. It is in the best interest of the Entrant to notify the Secretary of their pending absence as soon as possible in order to find an Alternate willing to take the Entrant's place.

Entrants declaring they are going to be absent and Alternates who withdraw must inform the Secretary in writing either via mail or email. Once an Alternate withdraws, they will not be considered as an Entrant replacement. Unless requested otherwise, the Secretary will refund entry fees by destroying the check. TD Certifications shall be returned via mail.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. The owner of a bitch in season **MUST** notify the Test Secretary and the judges prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitch (es) will run only after all other dogs have run and must be kept away from the immediate vicinity of the TD/TDX test prior to the running. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.
